Common Bond Qualifications for Membership

Admission to membership of the Credit Union is restricted to:

a) An individual who resides in, or is employed in the locality of East Yorkshire county or the area of North Lincolnshire Council or North East Lincolnshire Council or postcode areas YO14, YO17, YO8, DN14 or LN7 as delineated on the attached map in red.

b) A body corporate, an individual in his/her capacity as a partner in a partnership, an individual in his/her capacity as an officer of an unincorporated association, if the body corporate, partnership or unincorporated association has

- i. a place of business in the above locality.
- ii. the following significant connection with the above locality: is a housing provider to residents in the above locality.

c) An individual who is employed by the following employers:

- i. Sanctuary Housing
- ii. The HICA Group and subsidiaries
- iii. Yorkshire Housing.
- iv. Your Headrow
- v. The Department for Work and Pensions.

d) An individual who is otherwise associated with other individuals through:

- i. being a tenant of Sanctuary Housing
- ii. being a tenant of The HICA Group and subsidiaries
- iii. being a tenant of Yorkshire Housing
- iv. Your Headrow.

e) An individual who is a member of the same household as, and is a relative of, an individual who is a member of the credit union and falls directly within a common bond specified above.
